Schools as Core Social Centres- Parent Evening with George Krupinski

On Tuesday evening our third information session for parents tackled the topic of “**Enhancing resiliency and building positive self-esteem in children and adolescents**”. The very informative and engaging session was led by renowned parent educator George Krupinski. A couple of key points from the session included:

- “The role of parents is to produce an independent human being as early as is practicable”.
- A resilient person is one **who has**: trusting relationships; structure & rules at home; role models; encouragement to be autonomous; Conscious parenting (honour the moment); allows mistakes (face consequences of those mistakes); unconditional love; unconditional approval; **who is** lovable & likeable; respectful of self & others; tolerable & accommodating of conflicting interests; loving; empathic and altruistic; capable, autonomous and responsible and **who can** problem solve; decide between acting and seeking guidance; control extreme emotions and impulses; talk to others about fears & worries; find help

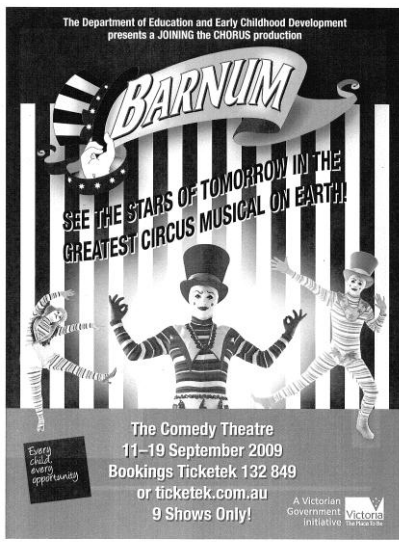

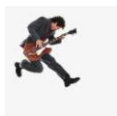
